THE 55+, 65+ WILL START AS ONE FIELD AND BE LIMITED TO 65 RIDERS. ALL WOMEN WILL START AS ONE FIELD WITH THE 45+ AND 55+ GOING TWO LAPS AND 35+ GOING THREE LAPS. THIS COMBINED WOMENS GROUP WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE 65 RIDER LIMIT.

PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED!! THERE WILL BE NO REGISTRATION ACCEPTED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE/TIME AS INDICATED ON THIS RACE INFORMATION OR AFTER A PARTICULAR FIELD IS FULL!!

There will be NO exceptions to the field limit or the pre-registration requirement. If you are contending for a top Maxxis Garden State Cup place the points available at this event are important and it behooves you to entry early to assure a start spot!!

Number Pickup: Will begin at 6 AM and conclude at 6:45 promptly. Be on time.

Directions: Locate Ringoes on a NJ map. It is several miles south of Flemington on Rt. 202. In the Ringoes area take Old York Rd. east for approx. 300M to the Larisons Corner Presbyterian Church parking lot. Look for BIKE RACE signs on Rt 202 exits. There is additional parking at the Wertsville Rd. School. Wertsville Rd. is approx. 1/2 mile further south on Rt. 202. Jughandle right to make a left turn on Wertsville Rd. and the school is 1/4 mile on the left.

PLEASE RESPECT THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS IN THE AREA. WE HAVE BEEN WELCOMED BACK EACH YEAR AND THIS IS DUE, IN PART, TO THE FACT THAT WE HAVE LEFT THE AREA LOOKING AS WE FOUND IT. PARKING IS A PROBLEM SO WE ASK THAT YOU FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF ANYONE SHOWING YOU WHERE TO PARK. WE HAVE ASSURED EAST AMWELL TWP. THAT THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO WRITING ON THE ROADWAY ANYWHERE ON THE COURSE.
